scope is an international network of researchers that synthesizes and assesses the scientific understanding on interactions between humans and the environment in the context of global change.



The Life Achievement Award on Environmental Sciences will be granted every two years to a scientist or scientists, or expert or experts, who have made significant contributions to moving the frontiers of environmental science and technological advances, or to environmental technology innovation and environmental engineering. A maximum of two Awards can be made in the same year.

Young Scientist Awards on Environmental Issues will be awarded annually to three young researchers who have made outstanding achievements or significant contributions in: 1) environmental sciences, 2) environmental technology, 3) environmental management.



The SCOPE-Zhongyu Environmental Awards is a 10-year programme that recognizes and encourages outstanding scientists who contribute to the improvement of the world environment through promotion of environmental sciences and technological advances.

The Scientific Committee on Problems of the Environment (SCOPE) and Zhongyu Environmental Technologies Corporation aim to sustain and guide the development of environmental science and technology, and to foster cooperation in environmental protection and management strategies.

2010 marks the first year of the SCOPE-Zhongyu Environmental Awards.

### Nomination of Candidate/s

Candidate/s may be nominated by the Members and Executive Committee of SCOPE, its partner agencies, and relevant national and international organizations.

Multiple nominations for either Award or in the different categories of the Young Scientist Award, are accepted. Applications from candidates themselves will not be considered.

The letter or statement should clearly indicate which Award, and in the case of the Young Scientists Award which category, the reasons and evidence to support the nomination and the relevance to the objectives of the Award.

The Awards may be discerned either to living individuals (not posthumously) or to legal persons or groups from all over the world.

#### The Awards Jury

The Jury, assisted by the non-voting Technical Secretariat, will designate the winning candidate/s by majority vote. The Jury's decision will be final.



## Life Achievement Award on Environmental Sciences 2010

This Award will be granted every two years (bi-ennial basis) to a scientist or scientists, or expert or experts, who have made a significant contribution to moving the frontiers of environmental science and technological advances or to environmental technology innovation and environmental engineering.

Candidates are senior scientists with an outstanding record on research in environmental sciences and technologies.

The Award is an engraved sculpture and a cheque for US\$ 15,000.

# Young Scientist Awards on Environmental Issues 2010

These Awards are granted to young researchers who have made significant contributions or

outstanding achievements in

- Environmental sciences
- Environmental technological innovations
- Environmental management

No more than three Awards, one in each of the

above categories, can be granted in any single year.

Candidates must be no older than 45 years old,

hold a doctoral degree (PhD), and attest to no less than five years' research experience and an outstanding research record.

Recipients of the 2010 Awards will be announced by 30 June 2010. The respective nominating body or individual will be informed at that time.

The President of SCOPE and the Director of the Board of Zhongyu or its representative will present the Awards at a ceremony organized in conjunction with an international workshop convened by SCOPE and its partners.
